Dear U. J.: Just as with any party, if the host is not paying the expenses, the activity for which the host is not paying cannot be included on the invitation. With this small of a group, word of mouth is the best way to convey the drink and dinner. People should not be obliged to attend the dinner and drinks afterwards, either.
